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1. Executive Summary

The main purpose of the “Deliverable 5.4 Knowledge exchange infrastructure/platform”, is to provide an active link for the AKIS knowledge exchange platform, and provide a short overview of the digital infrastructure that is being delivered.

This report is organized in 3 sections. The introduction provides an overview of the current status of the Knowledge exchange infrastructure/platform, accessible at <https://www.akisconnect.eu>.

Chapter 2 describes the scope of the platform and its context in modernAKIS project. Chapter 3 provides a brief description of the platform and its connection to EU-funded ATTRACTIS project. Chapter 4 presents some examples of pages that are included in the current delivery, whether as mockup screenshots or pages with actual dynamics data, already available before the initial launch. In Chapter 5, we explain briefly the next steps that we will follow after the initial release on March 1st, and how users' feedback will be integrated into the process.

The Agricultural University of Athens (AUA) is the partner responsible for documenting this report, as well as keeping it up to date with possible future alterations/modifications.

2. Introduction

This report aims to provide the active link for the AKIS knowledge exchange platform, at <https://www.akisconnect.eu>, accessible from March 1st 2024, to all interested stakeholders and visitors. It aims to also briefly document the work in “Task 5.2. Setting up the knowledge exchange infrastructure/platform” under the lead of AUA, which led to the creation and delivery of the AKIS Knowledge exchange infrastructure/platform. This work has taken place in the wider context of WP5 “Wider dissemination and engagement for impact”

The main objective of WP5 is to widely communicate, disseminate, and engage with AKIS actors in the most efficient way that ensures information and knowledge are better available, shared, and accessible between AKIS actors of the 27 EU MSs in the project. Its specific objectives are:

- Better connection between AKIS actors and practice-oriented information derived from different sources that are readily available (T5.1);
- Enhanced and shared use of new knowledge, tools, foresight, and environmental observations (T5.2);
- Develop awareness and engage the AKIS community, communicating the activities and disseminating the outcomes of modernAKIS (T5.3);
- Exploit the results after the project implementation, to enhance the capacity to further support the improving the functioning of MSs' AKIS (T5.4).

In the context of WP5, AUA has led “Task 5.2. Setting up the knowledge exchange infrastructure/ platform”, together with Task 5.2 participants and additional partners, following a multi-actor approach.

The effort undertaken in “Task 5.2. Setting up the knowledge exchange infrastructure/platform” which resulted in the delivery of the digital platform [akisconnect.eu](https://www.akisconnect.eu), has been closely linked to the continuing effort undertaken in “WP2: Framing and setting up a network of AKIS coordination bodies and other actors”, and especially “T2.4. Knowledge exchange platform: design, moderation, and operation (M01-M84)”, led by AUA, mainly together with the following participants: UGENT, CREA, ISP, APCA, TEAGASC, UHOH, AKI, FEUGA, but also incorporating more partners, and stakeholders as end-users of this platform. Task 2.4 continues throughout the modernAKIS projects' course. In its first related deliverable “D2.9 Report on Networking platform operation”, due M24, AUA together with the participating partners will document in a very thorough manner the methodology and all multi-actor activities that have been followed up to this point, regarding the design and development of the AKIS knowledge exchange platform, found in [akisconnect.eu](https://www.akisconnect.eu).

Results from T2.4 have been used as input for the development of a centralized open platform that will store all material collected in order to facilitate knowledge exchange among all AKIS actors. All factors taken into account are: (i) the database's architecture and specifications (relational or non-relational), (ii) back-end technology and front-end frameworks, and (iii) maintenance and update plan, in order to decide upon the exact required technology stack to be used for the development and deployment of the platform most efficiently and sustainably. A process for the data aggregation and database population has been thoroughly applied, based on the following principles: (i) close collaboration with the partners responsible for the data collection; (ii)

establishment of a data exchange framework (sharing tools, storage needs) to facilitate the data transfer; (iii) normalization of the data from its collection to final storage according to the data model; and (iv) final transformation and loading in the database by the designated administrators specified for this purpose. The platform has been developed in a way that will make it feasible for it to be “linked” to existing or future systems ensuring its sustainability, and will be embedded in the project website to be developed also for this task.

3. The akisconnect.eu platform

Initially and as described in the Grant Agreement, the AKIS knowledge exchange platform is foreseen to play a key role in smoothing the network functioning and serve the wider streamlining of the multi-actor approach adoption. The platform supports direct and mediated knowledge exchange among AKIS actors from across EU countries and regions and, at the same time, is instrumental for an ongoing monitoring of knowledge flows and needs for support from the project. Tools and functionalities of the platform will include spaces for open dialogue, constant access to the capacity-building toolbox, direct contact with the project facilitators, and others.

All the above general requirements have been taken into consideration, especially in the context of Task 2.4 where the AKIS Knowledge exchange infrastructure/platform, under the name akisconnect.eu has been designed. After the design process and the development phase that followed, a Minimum Viable Product is delivered, that incorporates all basic features and functionalities, to ensure that modernAKIS partners have a trustworthy and robust digital infrastructure to continue their efforts on providing their networking and capacity-building activities and services to all AKIS actors across Europe.

An important decision that has been made from the beginning during the kick-off meeting of modernAKIS together with the EU-funded sister project ATTRACTISS, is that the AKIS Knowledge exchange infrastructure/platform would be a joint platform for both projects, serving their common needs, messages, and joined target audience. The joint and parallel design process, which incorporated partners from both consortia, led to the delivery of akisconnect.eu, that will be thoroughly documented in the Deliverable “D2.9 Report on Networking platform operation”, due M24.

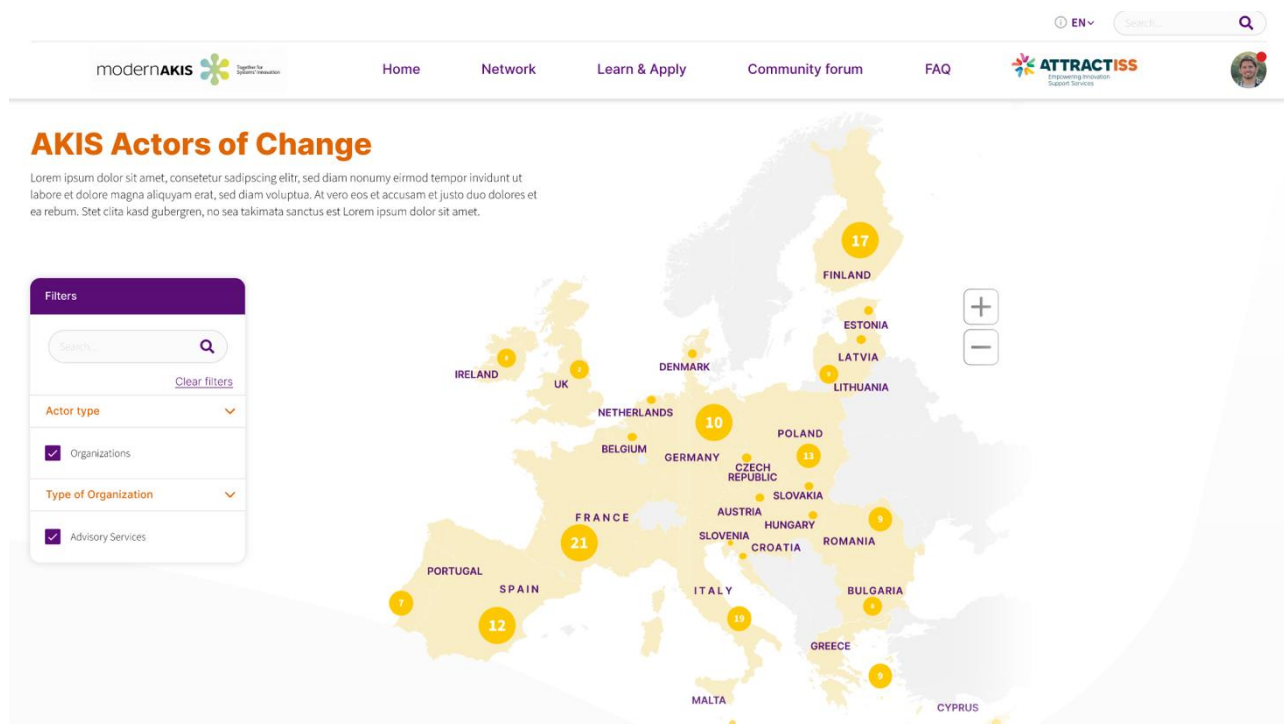

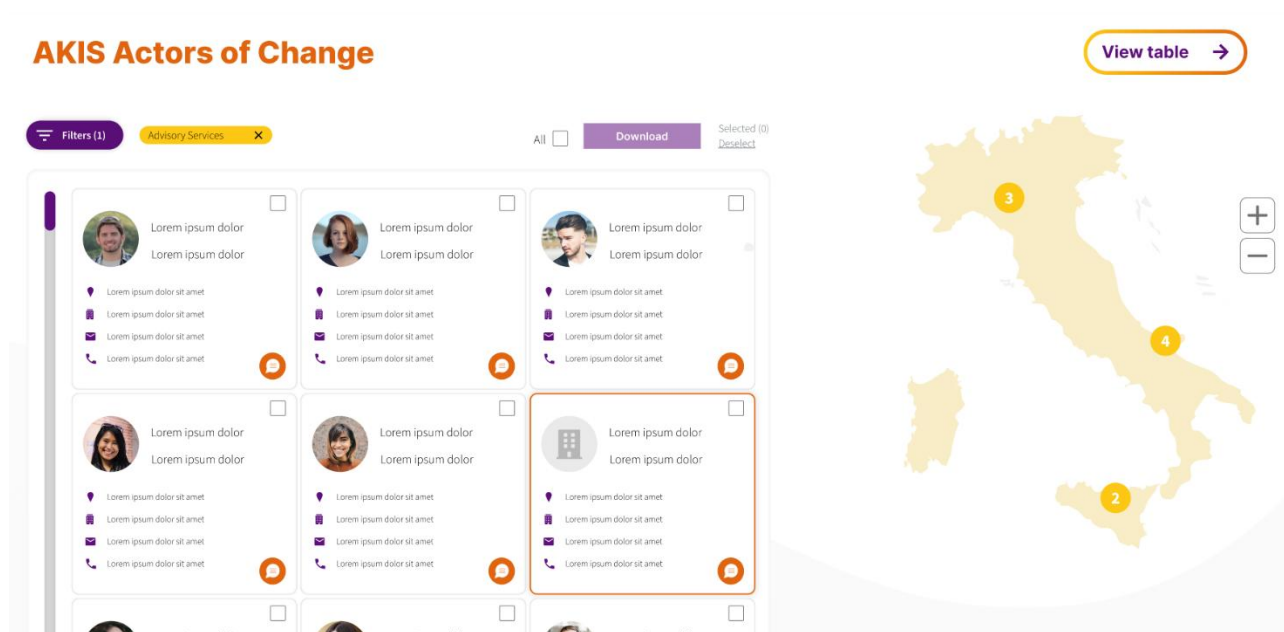

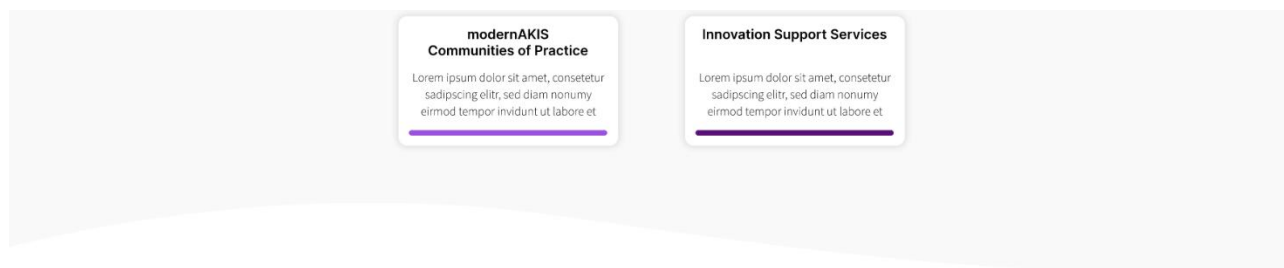

Rationale

What are the AKIS coordination bodies?

The institute of the AKIS-CBs represent the first attempt, within the European policies, to identify an institutional structure in charge of creating an enabling environment for innovation. Indeed, the introduction of this institute comes along with the acquisition of policy dignity of the AKIS and their strategies, which main goal is to strengthen the agricultural systems in rural areas and contribute to more competitive and sustainable primary sector in Europe (Cristiano et., al, 2023; D1.1). So that, AKIS coordinating bodies (AKIS-CB) are new governing actors of the CAP SPs 2023-2027, which responsible are identified under chapters 8 of the CAP SPs and which overall goal is to enable the environment for well-functioning AKISs, through fostering cooperation, effectively combining the interventions of the CAP Strategic Plans and satisfying the need for a quicker, more qualitative and more inclusive AKIS.

Approaches and roles of AKIS coordination bodies in CAP-SPs

Indeed, as it emerges from the study on the comparative analysis of the AKIS in EU (Fanos et al. 2023; D1.10), "the managing authorities play a pivotal role in strategizing the AKIS coordination and serving as the umbrella organization". While the strategic coordination tasks are taken up by the managing authorities, multiple approaches/models are observed across the CAP-SPs for the operational coordination tasks. Firstly, the different institutional configuration of AKIS, with some having the competence for the primary sector at national and some at regional levels makes some difference, by shaping more centralized or decentralized approaches to AKIS coordination. For example, "in MSs with a decentralized AKIS organization, particularly Germany, Italy and Spain, role of AKIS-CBs at the national level is dedicated to bringing regional or provincial AKIS coordination bodies together by setting up a working group or an advisory board in which the group proposes an overall strategy and facilitate knowledge exchange between the regions" (Birke et al. 2023; D1.10).

Which functions to ensure an overall AKIS Coordination

As a matter of fact, the only reference to the responsibilities and tasks of AKIS CBs is provided by a tool of the Tool 8.1 Tool for the CAP Cross-Cutting Objective (EC, 2021) that proposes the followings:

- Acting as the contact point for the Commission as regards the governance and coordination of the AKIS strategic approach.
- Organising the advice and advisors and all other related AKIS interventions.
- Keeping close and regular contact with the main AKIS (regional) coordinators and actors in the country by giving suggestions for encouragement of more effective knowledge exchange activities (advice, training, ...), including also the generation and co-creation of innovation (EIP OGs) and the broad sharing of it.

The organisation of national AKISs and the degree of public sector engagement in the AKIS governance entail differences in how AKIS-CBs may implement their coordination tasks:

- AKIS-CBs in centralized AKIS governance with strong engagement of managing authorities may have a more focused mandate at the national level with a well-defined hierarchical structure that also influence the coordination efforts.
- AKIS-CBs in a centralized AKIS governance with medium or low engagement of managing authorities need to navigate their coordination by aligning between the state and non-state structures, which may be diverse and flexible.
- AKIS-CBs in a decentralized AKIS governance will need to facilitate coordination among

5. Next steps

Apart from the pages that have been already presented and will be available in akisconnect.eu, from March 1st, 2024, additional features and functionalities have been foreseen and already designed. These will be gradually incorporated into the platform following an agile software development methodology, according to which they will be delivered in iterative cycles, based on the partners' delivery of content and users' needs and feedback that will dictate the delivery prioritization. This process, together with the next cluster of features and functionalities to be delivered, will be documented in "*D2.9 Report on Networking Platform Operation*", due M24, meaning on August 2024. In this report, all decisions related to the digital infrastructure, database architecture, technology stack used, user types and their rights, will be explicitly described, and will be associated to the multi actor process that has been contacted during the months before this initial release, and the months that followed, when the akisconnect.eu platform will be available for the AKIS actors, as targeted users, to test and validate, and provide their feedback and additional needs.
